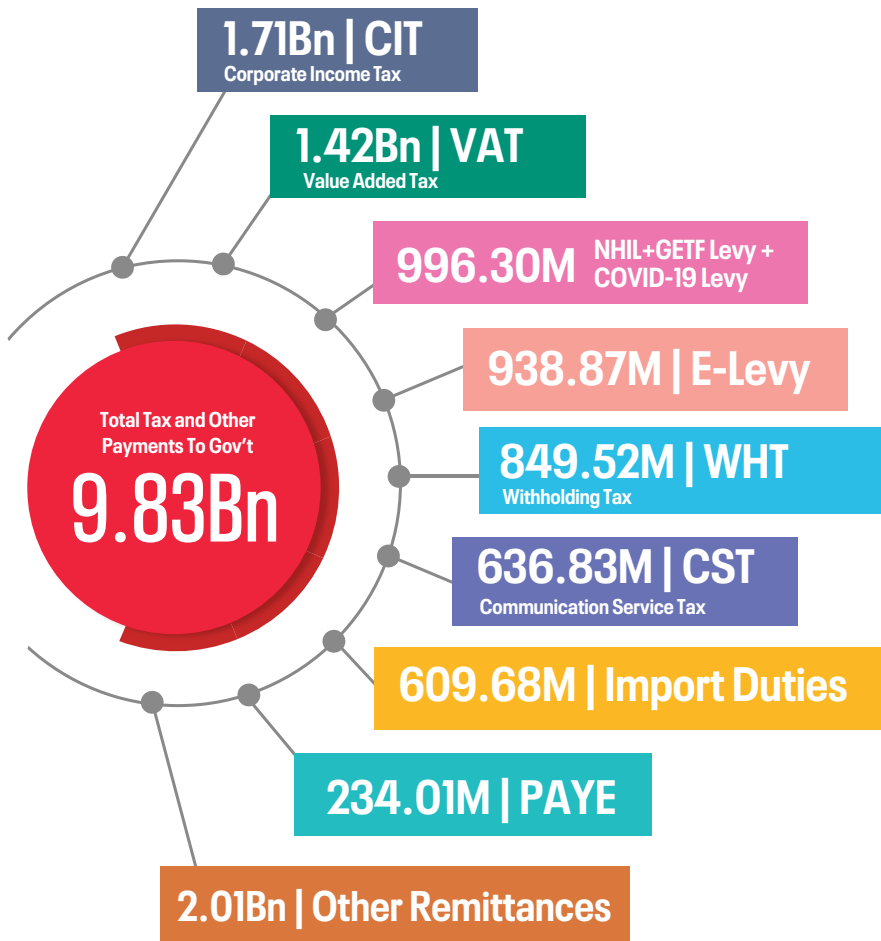

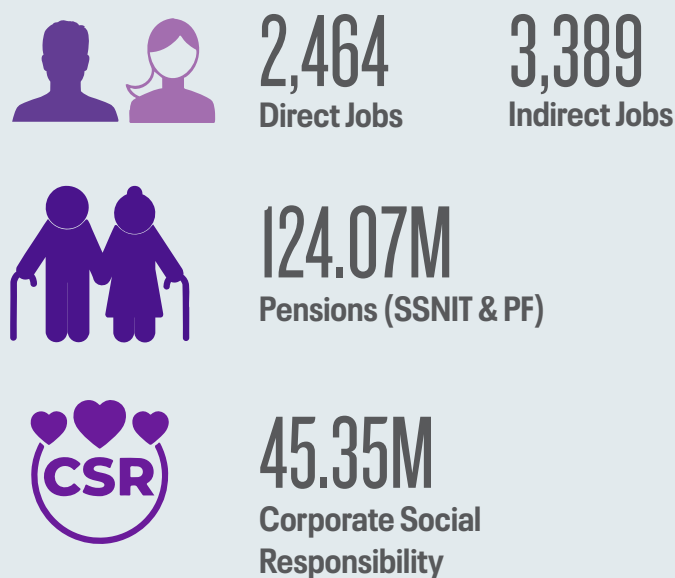


» TOTAL TAX CONTRIBUTION

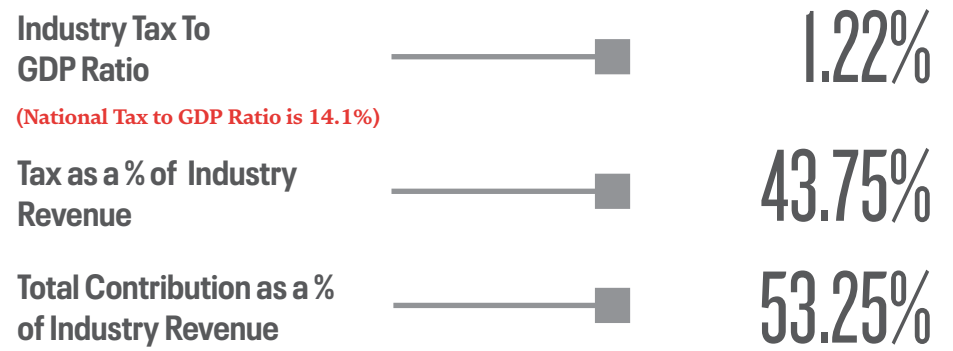


Total taxes borne, collected and other remittances made to government and allied agencies resulted in total payments of **9.84 billion Ghana cedis**. This contribution forms approximately **7.38%** of Ghana's 2023 total revenue less grants.

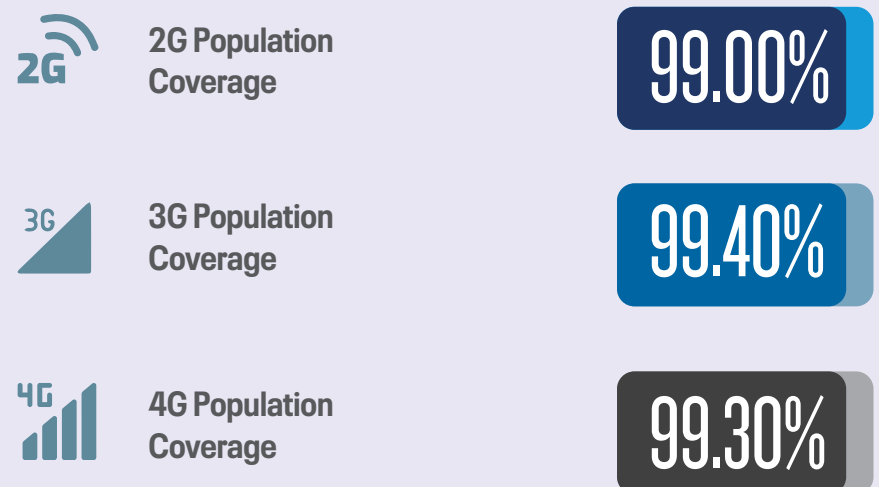
» PEOPLE CONTRIBUTION



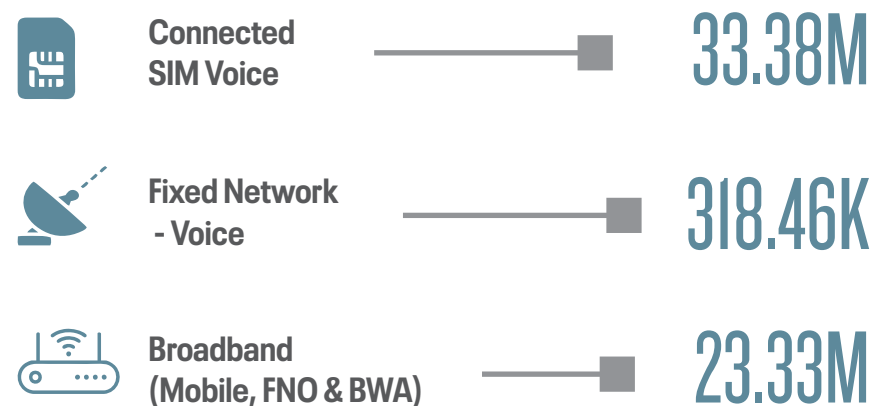
» CONTRIBUTION TO GDP & TAX

Ghana's mobile sector enables about 35 million mobile connections, allowing the population to access the benefits of mobile communications. Mobile penetration impacts jobs, GDP, tax revenues, investments, productivity and socio-economic growth.

» MOBILE FINANCIAL SERVICES



Mobile money in Ghana significantly boosts financial inclusion by extending access to financial services for the unbanked, particularly MSMEs, fostering economic growth. This improved access to credit and payments facilitates increased productivity, wealth creation, and overall socio-economic development.
